One scholarship each year is offered to a graduate candidate in a physical science, engineering or mathematical subject. Relevant fields include Engineering and Electrical Sciences, Manufacturing, Engineering, Mathematics, Medicine, Natural Sciences and Computer Science. The candidate, who will be of considerable distinction, will be selected by Jesus College. Applications are accepted from PhD candidates with Greek, Greek Cypriot or British nationality.

The holder of the Scholarship must be, or seek to be, a candidate for the first year of the PhD degree at the University of Cambridge. Funding will be made available for three years maximum, subject to satisfactory research progress. Graduates who have already started their doctorate are not eligible. Applicants should apply directly through the College Graduate Office should have indicated Jesus College as their first choice in their University application.

The scholarship will make an annual contribution to maintenance expenses of up to £12,000. Applicants are expected to identify additional funding sources to make up the difference. It is hoped that all applicants will have been accepted for study by the University before the scholarship application deadline of **31 March 2012**.
