The candidate who will be of considerable distinction will be selected by Jesus College. The scholarship is worth approximately £600 a year. The successful applicant could be admitted for a one-year Master's course or a three year PhD. In the latter case, the award could be granted for three years, but applicants should re-apply annually. Applicants need to apply directly through the College Graduate Office and to have indicated Jesus College as their first choice in their application to the Board of Graduate Studies. Current Jesus students are also eligible.
