

STUDENT SUPPORT

Nearly 300 students at Jesus receive some form of financial support from the College. In these days of ever increasing higher education costs, it is important that the College has at its disposal the funds to help those in financial need, be it for a core bursary, graduate scholarship or grant towards course essentials such as textbooks or field trips.

With your continued help we can ensure that the best young minds, from all backgrounds, will be encouraged to apply to Jesus and to thrive here.

The value of bursaries ranges from £50 to £3,500 per annum. Last year the College awarded a record £325,795 to 110 undergraduates.

The full cost of a graduate degree at Jesus College ranges from £21,000 to £44,000. Through the generous support of our alumni and friends we are able to offer a number of graduate scholarships. The College is seeking to increase this number, especially in the Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences which are under-represented at graduate level, to ensure the next generation of scholars can make its mark.

ACCESS AND OUTREACH

The College is committed to widening access to our world-class education through the outreach programme. This aims to encourage and enthuse young people to apply to Cambridge regardless of school or background.

More widely, we hope to raise the aspirations of young people and inspire them to continue to further and university education.

Many of our current students have taken part in our Year 10 residentials and taster days. We also run access tours, which travel to the London Boroughs of Ealing, Brent, and Westminster; Tyne and Wear; and Peterborough.

Although our focus in recent years has been on West Court, the ongoing maintenance to our historic buildings continues. The College invests in a rolling programme of repair, renovation and modernisation which is necessary if our facilities are to serve today's requirements and be preserved for future generations.

Currently, the College is upgrading undergraduate and graduate accommodation on Jesus Lane and Malcolm Street.
